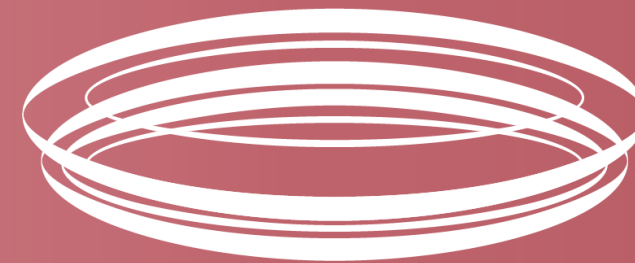

6.ANTI-DOPING



Anti-doping will be conducted by the National Anti-Doping Agency (ADAS).

Selected athletes will be transported to Hotel "M" (2 minutes by car) with doping control officer. After doping control is done in Hotel "M", LOC will provide transportation back to the competition venue, or to the official hotel.

If an athlete needs a compay person to come with them, please ask Anti-doping or LOC staff.

For aditional doping control test, please refer to TIC.

7.COMPETITION



A. OFFICIAL TRAINING

Official training is scheduled for Tuesday, 10 February from 17:00 until 19:00h.
Training with the starter will be from 17:30 until 18:30.

B. COMPETITION PROGRAM

Men events: 60m, 400m, 3000m, 60m Hurdles, Long Jump, Shot Put

Women events: 60m, 800m, 1500m, 60m Hurdles, Long Jump, High Jump

C. TIC

TIC is located at the first door to the right, after you enter the Competition venue through the Athlete entrance.

TIC WORKING HOURS:

10 February: 15:00-20:00h

11 February: 12:00-21:00h

D. BIBs



BIBs will be given to the athletes in the Warm-up area at the check point. Each athlete will receive two BIBs. BIBs must be worn on the front and back.

For all jumping events, athletes can use only one BIB on the chest or back.

Photo finish Bibs will be distributed in main Call room.

E. CALL ROOM

All athletes must report to First Call at the Warm-up area as per the call room timetable.

From the First Call athletes will be escorted to the Call room.

All standard procedures will be conducted in the call room: BIB check, spikes check, advertising.

All confiscated items in the Call room can be collected at the TIC after the event.

FOR ALL EVENTS UP TO 9 mm SPIKES ARE ALLOWED.

F. WARM-UP



Warm-up area is located at the outdoor track, next to the competition venue.

The Warm-up area is covered and provides use of six lanes, LJ/TJ runaway with landing area.

All necessary equipment is provided and can be requested with Warm-up area staff.

Note: Athletes are required to go outside (less than 30m) to enter the Competition venue from the Warm-up area.

G. IMPLEMENTS AND SHOT PUT ARCS

Personal implements must be submitted to the TIC during the official training session.

Implements can be collected at the TIC after the end of the event.

I. RACES CONDUCTS

60m MEN - 3Q + 2q

60m WOMEN - 3Q + 2q

60m H MEN - Straight finals

60m H WOMEN - 2Q + 2q

1500m WOMEN and 3000m MEN - Straight finals

400m MEN and 800m WOMEN - Finals by heats (2 heats per race)

800m women races will start from one line.

PACE:

800m WOMEN race 1- 58.5 for 400m

800m WOMEN race 2- 57.5 for 400m

1500m WOMEN - 2:08 for 800m

3000m MEN - 2:31 for 1000m



J. STARTERS COMMAND

Starters command will be given in English.

K. ATHLETES PRESENTATION

Athele presetation will be conducted for all events.

Athletes are **required** to participate! All athletes will be instructed by officials and floor managers during the presentation.

L. MIXED ZONE

All athletes must exit the field of play as instructed by Marshalls.
All athletes are required to go through the Mixed zone!

M. KIT COLLECTION

For all track events athletes will leave the Call Room ready to run. All the items will be transferred to the Kit Collection area which is located after the Mixed Zone.
For all Field events, athletes may take the bag with them. Please try to use only one medium size bag.

N. SHOE CONTROL



Athletes must go through the shoe control if selected by shoe control officer.

Shoe control will take place **ONLY AFTER** the event!

Please note that athletes are responsible for using the shoes from the “LIST OF APPROVED ATHLETIC SHOES”.

Before the event, please check if the shoes are on the list for the specific event.

Note: Referee has right to check the shoes if they deem it appropriate.

O. COACHES

All coaches must wear their accreditation!

To access coaches zones for field events, coaches must report to TIC at the Call room time for specific event.

Coaches will be escorted from TIC. They must leave the Coaches zone after the event is over.

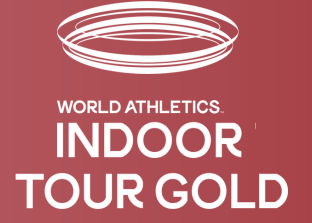
Only one coach per athlete is allowed in the coaches zone.

P. FINAL 3 FORMAT

In all field events, except High Jump, all athletes will have 3 attempts, then best 8 athletes will progress to rounds 4 and 5 and only the best 3 athletes, after round 5 will progress to round 6. For the first 3 rounds the order of competing will be determined by the organisers. After round 3 athletes will be ranked so that the best performing athlete after round 3 will compete first, then the second best, etc. Same principle is applied to round 6 to determine the order of best 3 athletes.

Winner of the Final 3 event is the athlete with the best performance after all 6 attempts.

Q. PHONE USE IN THE FIELD OF PLAY



Athelets are allowed to bring the phone to the field of play if previously declared to the Call room, or the event Referee.

Please remember:

- Phone must be on silent
- No calls of any sort are allowed
- Messaging is allowed
- Watching of videos from coaches is allowed
- While watching a video keep the volume down
- Must not be used in proximity of runway or circles to avoid disturbing other athletes

REMINDER: rights to moving images of the competetion are protected and therefore cannot be shared on social media or other means of communication.

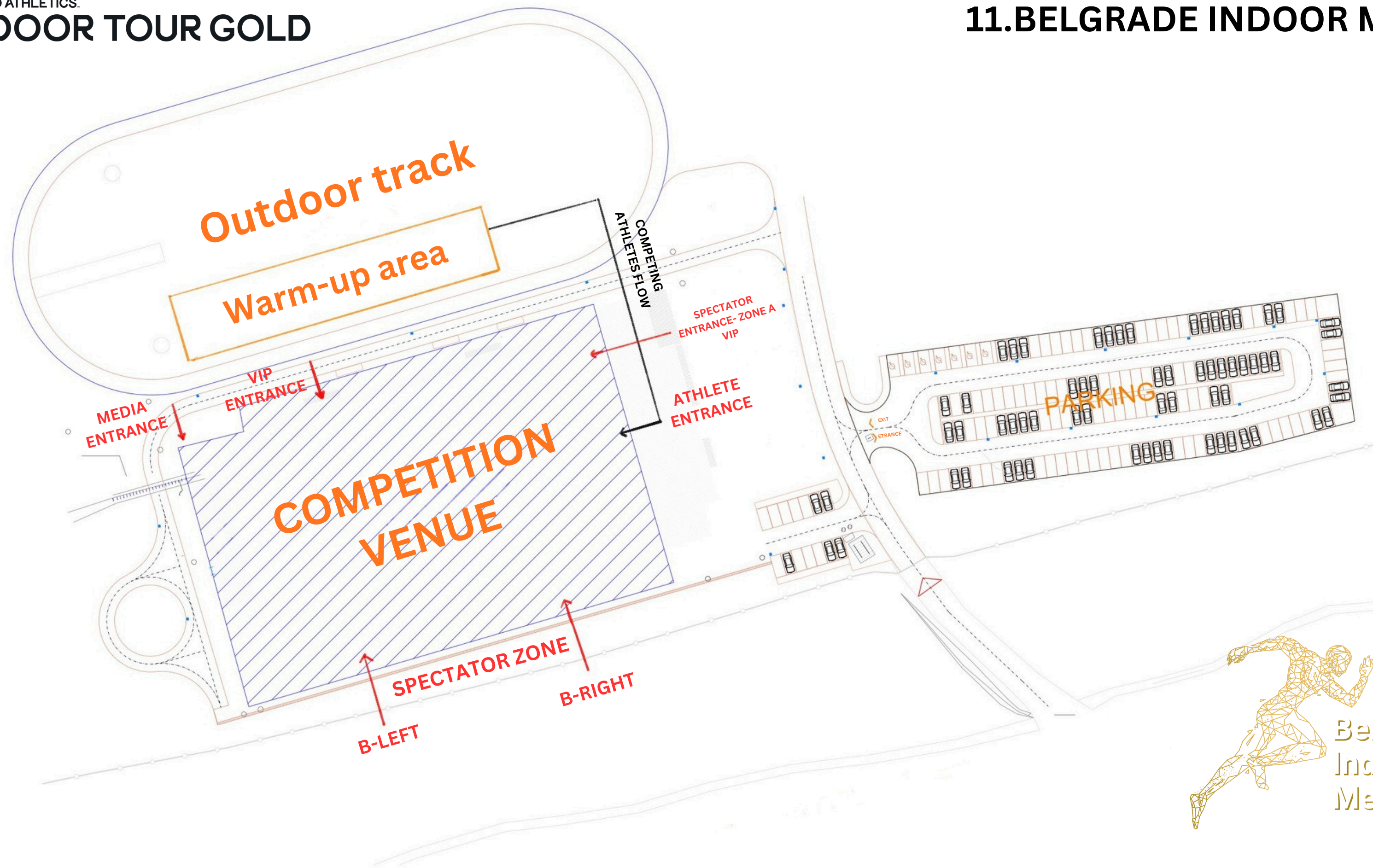

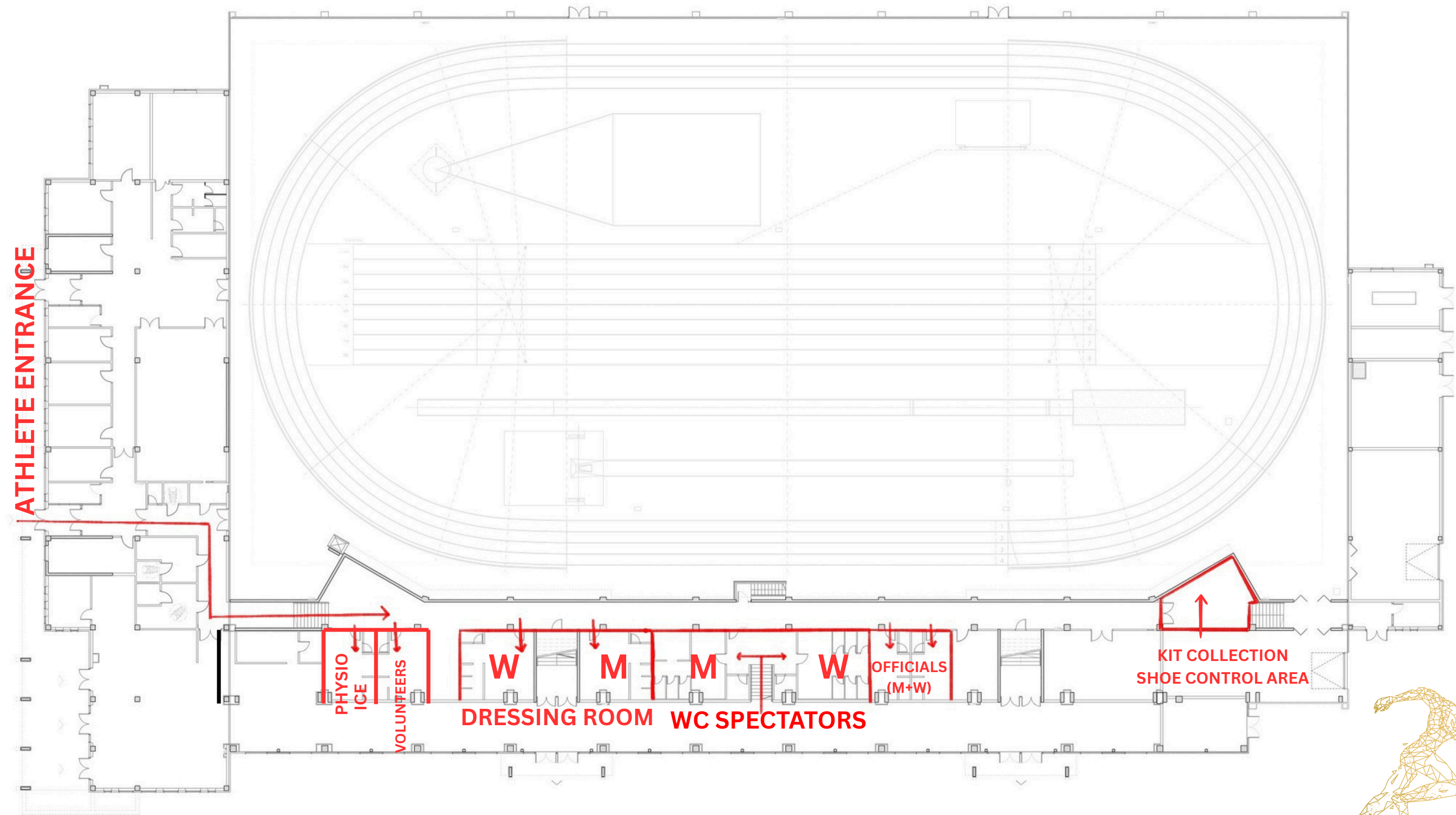
